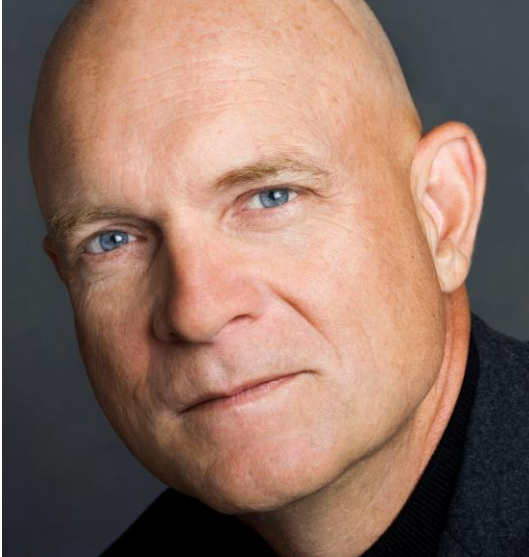


Jacques Beauchamp

Biographical Note

Mr. Beauchamp was appointed to the position of President and General Manager of Petro-Nav Inc. in January 2011. Petro-Nav, which is a wholly owned subsidiary of Group Desgagnés, services the maritime transportation needs of Eastern Canada's petroleum and petrochemical industries. It specializes in the transportation of bulk petroleum products, and chemicals on the Great Lakes, the St. Lawrence River, the Eastern Canadian Arctic and the Canadian and U.S. East Coast. Petro-Nav also transports crude oil on the St. Lawrence and in

the Atlantic Basin. The company enjoys a long-term relationship with several major oil companies.

Mr. Beauchamp is also a well known former executive in the Canadian energy industry. He has extensive knowledge and experience in the areas of refinery and chemical plant operations, energy trading, transportation logistics, environmental stewardship, information technology, and governmental regulatory frameworks. Mr. Beauchamp served 10 years as President of Petromont Inc, a leading Petrochemical and Plastic Resin Manufacturer based in Montreal. Prior to this role Mr. Beauchamp spent 20 years with Shell Canada progressing through the positions of Operations Manager, National Incident Commander, Director of Distribution and General Manager –Manufacturing for the Sarnia Refinery.

As Director of Distribution Mr. Beauchamp was responsible for Shell Canada's Terminal Operations, Transportation Logistics (including marine), and all of Shell's Arctic Sealift Operations.

Mr. Beauchamp also served on the Board and the Executive Committee of the Canadian Chemical Producers Association as well as being a founding Board Member of the Eastern Canada Response Corporation (ECRC) and the Great Lakes Response Corporation (GLRC).
